Notes

1. Attention is drawn to the legal requirements of Article 2 of the Law, the relevant parts of which are summarized overleaf.
2. The application envisages the issue of a licence to an individual trader. Applications by companies should give the names and addresses of all directors in a schedule, which must accompany this application.
3. Applications must reach the Finance and Economics Committee not less than fourteen days before the date on which the applicant desires the licence to come into force – but see Note 2 overleaf.

Notes

1. Article 2 of the Hawkers and Non - Resident Traders (Jersey) Law 1965 provides inter alia, that: -
 2. (1) An application for the grant of a licence _____ shall be accompanied:
 - (a) by a remittance for the fee _____ and
 - (b) (ii) by a certificate signed by the Mayor or Chief Officer of Police of the place of residence of the applicant to the effect that the applicant is know to have been of good repute for the period of twelve months immediately preceding the date of application.
 - (2) A licence shall not be granted in any case where:-
 - (a) The Committee is not satisfied that the certificate furnished in pursuance of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of this Article shows the applicant to be fit and proper person to hold a licence.
 - (b) The applicant has, within the twelve months immediately preceding the date of his application for the grant of a licence, been convicted of an offence by any Court.

Providing that this sub-paragraph shall not apply to an offence, not being an offence under this Law, in respect of which no sentence of imprisonment may be imposed.
2. Completed applications for a licence to participate in a trade fair must in the first instance be forwarded to The Customer Services Department at the Town Hall St Helier Jersey JE4 8PA who will remit them to the Finance and Economics Committee.
3. A non-resident trader's licence issued for the fee of £150.00 is restricted to participation by the licensee in the trade fair specified in the application submitted and for the period of that fair only and for no other purpose.
